

Sidewalks - White Oak toward East side: estimated cost ? Ollis stated he doesn't have a figure for the sidewalks. Ingham stated beyond Roseland Center it would seem impossible.

Hollywood sign: estimated cost \$5,000

Fences: estimated cost \$4,000

John Vining has put in his request for re-staining the bathrooms at Rogers Park: estimated cost \$4,000

He has also asked for the pergolas to be rebuilt at Rogers Park: estimated cost \$15,000. Armbrust stated they are in bad shape, but he could live with them another year. Ollis stated he would love to have a new pergola on the top side, where they collect donations at Summer Tracks and if weddings were held a woman could walk under it. Ingham asked if Adrian could build that. Ollis stated Adrian can do about anything, but he has been pulled off from some of the things he has been doing. Ollis suggested replacing both next year. Armbrust stated that seems to be a good project for the Polk County Community Foundation.

Other than that Pam needs a printer at a cost of \$200.

Armbrust asked if this included infrastructure. Ollis stated no, that is included in the CIP. Armbrust asked about training funds for the boards and volunteers. Ollis stated he has \$4,000 in the budget now. Ingham stated it needs to be utilized. Armbrust asked how much had been utilized. Crowell asked where would they go for this training? Armbrust stated the School of Government. Ollis stated he budgeted \$8,000 and we have spent \$515 to date. He cut it this year because it hasn't been used. Armbrust stated that needs to be included in the application process. Ingham stated we have some very talented smart people on our boards.

Jerry Soderquist stated the archive website is up and running. The board thanked him for what he does.

Ollis stated as far as everything else goes he needs to figure out some stuff with sanitation. The next meeting, he hopes to have TDDA here to discuss the position to replace Jamie Carpenter.

Ingham stated he would like to see the front of the Police Department redone.

Armbrust asked if we had excess furniture. Ollis stated no. The last surplus furniture we had we gave to the Tryon Archives. Armbrust was asking for Big Brother Big Sisters.

Armbrust asked after three or four years he would like to have on-site counsel, whether it be in the building or in the city. Ollis stated when we advertised, we only had one from Polk County to submit an application. Ingham stated if you know of someone that is interested bring them in.

Armbrust asked if we are going to continue funding with the Museum. Ollis stated he has that included it in the budget.

Armbrust asked about the status of the parking lot owned by the Butlers. Ollis has asked to buy the parking lot, but he thinks he will sell with the building. He has talked with the new owner of the Shops of Tryon building. He has stated that he is going to repair the wall and parking area.

Armbrust asked when is the earliest date we can start on the projects. Ollis asked what project. Armbrust stated Chestnut. Ollis stated as soon as the new budget goes into effect. The others can be done as worked in.

Ollis will contact Gordon about the next meeting on Monday, February 24th at noon.

Ingham reminded everyone of the county meeting on Monday.

Armbrust stated on tourism related stuff, he has an interview at 12:00 on Friday with French television about Nina Simone.
