## **CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Peoples called the work session to order.

## Items discussed:

- 1. Mayor Pro Tem Booker wanted to discuss No Parking Ordinance on Lyle Street. Kenan Nesbitt spoke in opposition of the ordinance. He had reached out to Polk County to find out how many complaints have been received in the last three years. Only four calls had been received. If you are going to make an ordinance for one street, it is needed on all streets. Janice Wyatt spoke in favor of the ordinance. It is very difficult getting through with cars parked in the street. Maria Capossa reported they have to park in the street when they have company. Timothy Brown commented any street in Tryon, you have to park on the street. Commissioner Ingham asked how many cars Mr. Nesbitt. Mr. Nesbitt responded two cars in driveway. Mayor Pro Tem Booker wants lines drawn down the middle of road. Vanessa Nesbitt reported there are a lot of streets where people park on the side of road and nobody complains, because that is the way it has always been.
- 2. Mayor Pro Tem Booker has ended her presidency with the NLC WIMG group. She reported there are federal grants out there and working with another state helps to get them. Manager Fatland reported NCLM has grant writers available. Mayor Pro Tem Booker reported they also have grants for cybersecurity
- 3. Commissioner Ingham has concerns about Braewick Road getting fixed
- 4. Mayor Peoples thanked staff for working on the fence-Manager Fatland responded it was a team effort with the Public Works Crew helping. The Town split the cost of supplies with White Oak.
- 5. Commissioner Crowell-street lights are getting fixed
- 6. Mayor Peoples-asked about the business that recently got flooded, because of the underground drilling done by someone-Manager Fatland asked where-he will work on this.

Mayor Peoples entertained a motion to adjourn the work session. Commissioner Crowell so moved. The motion carried unanimously.
